CIRCULATION	A collection of print materials is available along with the EBSCOhost eBook collection. Currently registered Calhoun students may check out up to 5 books for 21 days with one renewal. Community patrons may check out up to 2 books for 21 days with no renewal.

	Through contractual agreements, Calhoun students and staff may check out books at UAH, Alabama A&M, Drake, and Athens State. Calhoun students and employees must show current identification as a student or employee at the cooperating library. Please note: UAH charges Calhoun users an annual \$25 user fee to check out materials.

INFORMATION	Other General Information Is As Follows:
Pharos Printing	All users who print from Library workstations are required to log into their account at <a href="https://cccprint.calhoun.edu/myprintcenter/">https://cccprint.calhoun.edu/myprintcenter/</a> The login is the same as your MyCalhoun login. Follow the steps to add funds to your account. Pharos Printing is \$.10 per page. Funds can only be added to your account through the use of PayPal, Debit or Credit Card.
Copies	A photocopy machine is available for public use and is coin and/or bill operated at \$.10 per page. The Library cannot make change for bills.
Cell Phones	Talking on a cell phone is not acceptable inside the Library. Before entering, turn cell phones to Silent Mode (mute). Place and accept calls outside of the Library.
Tobacco Weapons	Calhoun Community College is a tobacco-free and weapons-free campus.
Food and Drink	Drinks are allowed anywhere in the Library. Drinks and snacks may be taken into the SunRoom (MindLab) and the Delmore Room.
Study Rooms	Study rooms can be used for groups of 3 or more up to 3 hours. Inquire at the Front Desk.
Special Accommodation	If you require special accommodations due to documented disability (ADA), please ask for assistance from Library staff.
